Clothing needed (as of 6/28/23):

- Sneakers:
Adults: men sizes 7-9, women 4-7
Children: sizes 10-4Y (boys and girls)
Please donate only sneakers instead of other shoes or sandals
- Boys pants and shorts, sizes 2T (toddler) up to size 16 (boys)
- Short sleeve shirts for children, sizes 5-10 (small and medium), both boys and girls
- Short Sleeve T-shirts for men, size small only
- Sweatshirts and hoodies for men and women (small-large) and for children (all sizes)
- Bras for women: small/medium sports bras, 32-36A-C regular bras

Please do NOT bring the following.

Our volunteers sort through many bags of donations each week and find many items that are not in good condition or are not needed.

Please help save us time by only donating items that are requested and in good condition.

- **Swimsuits**
- Winter coats
- Women's clothing: no dresses/skirts, no crop tops, no sweaters
- Office wear or evening wear.
- High heels or men's/women's office shoes.
- Winter boots, rain boots, or fashion boots
