Monday, January 4, 2010 at 8 p.m.

Eric Plutz, University Organist at Princeton University, kicks off the first “Musical Mondays” concert of the new year. Playing the newly restored Whitelegg Möller pipe organ at Capitol Hill United Methodist Church, he will perform organ transcriptions of orchestral works, among other selections. Mr. Plutz, a former dean of the DC Chapter of the American Guild of Organists, has been described by The Washington Post as “a spirited and virtuosic organist.” Live video will give the audience a birds-eye view of the athleticism and musical dexterity required by the console work.



The free Musical Mondays Concert series featuring renowned virtuosi playing Capitol Hill United Methodist Church’s newly restored pipe organ - a 1939 Whitelegg-designed masterpiece that ranks as one of the most exquisite instruments in the city.
